

Auction Terms & Conditions

1. Identification - All purchasers are required to supply Brussels Airlines with their full name, email address and telephone number.
2. The auctioneer has the right at his absolute discretion to refuse any bid. The highest bidder shall be the buyer at the hammer price (midnight on 12 December). One shall always place a higher bid than the current bid, lower bids will be added to the database, but are not able to win.
3. Dispute between bidders - If any dispute arises between two or more bidders, the auctioneer may decide the same or may immediately put the lot up for sale again, and resell to the highest bidder. The decision of the auctioneer shall be final and absolute.
4. Condition of items sold - The auctioneer shall not be responsible for the correct description, authenticity, genuineness of, estimated selling price and makes no warranty in connection therewith.
5. Manner of payment - All lots are to be paid in full via bank transfer after the close of the auction. The auctioneer will contact the highest bidder to arrange payment.
6. Minimum bids - the auction for every item starts at 50,00 euro, except for the simulator session, which starts at 200€
7. End of bidding - The auction ends on 12 December at midnight
8. All bids are binding and sales are final.
9. Description of items for sale:
 - 9.1 Cockpit experience
The buyer will spend a half day with Captain Kirsten, follow the flight preparations in Brussels Airlines headquarters, go with the crew to the tarmac, follow the walk-around with the captain and fly to a later determined destination and back on the cockpit jumpseat. The time and date will be discussed with the buyer after the auction has ended.
 - 9.2 Hangar experience
Our Head of Cabin Engineering will give the buyer a tour around the Brussels Airlines hangar in Brussels, near Brussels Airport. This will take approximately 2 hours. The day and time will be discussed with the buyer after the auction has ended.
 - 9.3 Flight Attendant experience
The buyer will fly on a same-day return flight with our cabin crew member Steven to one of the Brussels Airlines destinations and will be able to help out as a commercial flight attendant. The day and time will be discussed with the buyer after the auction has ended.
 - 9.4 Flight Simulator session
The buyer will join captain and flight instructor Niki for a two-hour session in the flight simulator at CAE school near Brussels Airport. The day and time will be discussed with the buyer after the auction has ended.
 - 9.5 Nightstop experience
The buyer gets to invite 10 people of his choice and will come to the Brussels Airlines hangar near Brussels Airport, where Ozark Henry will play an intimate piano concert in between the aircraft. The day and time will be discussed with the buyer after the auction has ended.
 - 9.6 Belgian Icon cockpit experience
The buyer will come to Brussels Airlines headquarters in Diegem, where he will be met by captain Hilde, follow the flight preparations in Brussels Airlines headquarters, go with the crew to the tarmac, follow the walk-around with the captain and fly to a later determined destination and back on the cockpit jump seat of the Belgian Icon plane of his/her choice. The time and date will be discussed with the buyer after the auction has ended.
 - 9.7 Ozark Henry piano concert
The buyer gets to invite 10 of his or her friends to attend an intimate piano concert in the hangar of Brussels Airlines. The day and time will be discussed with the buyer after the auction has ended.
